Recording with Your Heroes

Two of our camp instructors will be available to coach and then record a song/tune with any campers who choose to sign up for the recording experience. You may sign up on Friday at any time for the available slots. You can do a duet with the instructor or get a group of campers together – however you want to do it! You will have scheduled time on Saturday afternoon to connect with your instructor to get an arrangement together and rehearse. If you ask around amongst the other instructors or your camp directors, you might have the option of additional rhythm guitar, fiddle, or vocals on your recording. On the day of the recording, all the campers will gather in the studio (Andy's House) for a briefing on the recording process and then each of the groups will record their song – each group can take a couple of passes at the recording so there's no need to be nervous. If you don't choose to record, make sure to take advantage of a last chance jam class happening simultaneously.
